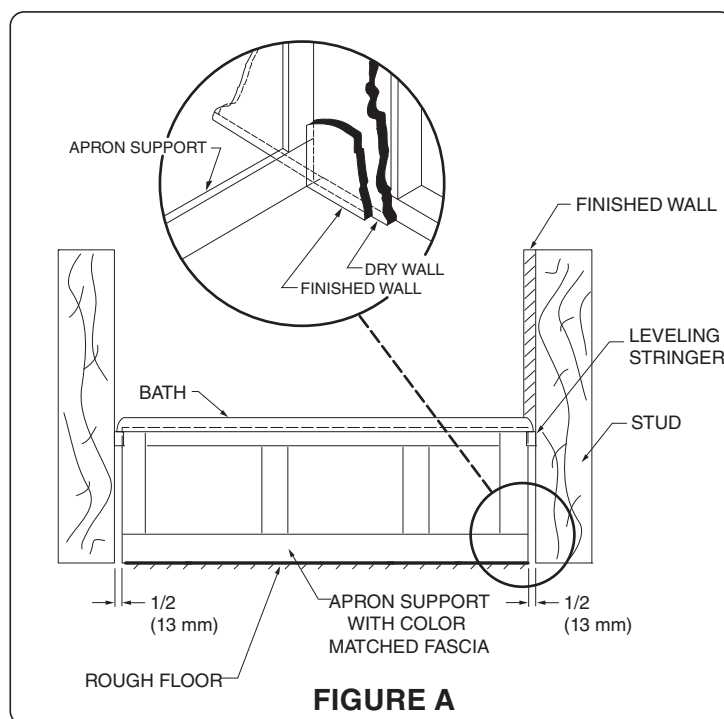

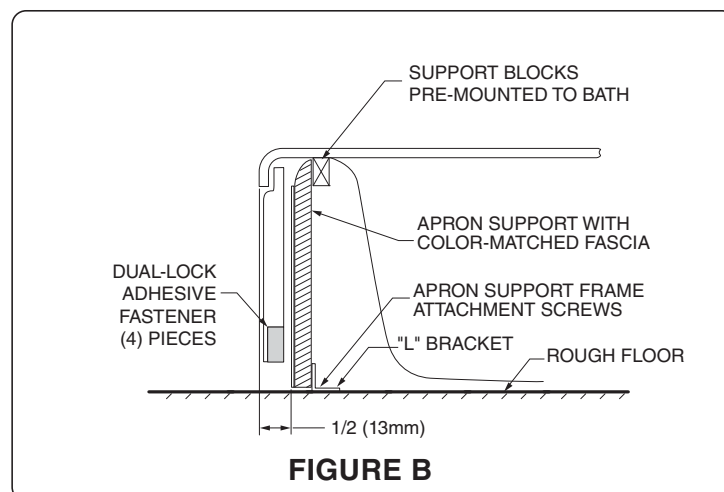
EVERCLEAN - 6FT APRON (9271.019.XXX)

Important: please follow the installation instructions enclosed in the whirlpool bathtub. The apron kit is designed with an apron and a supporting frame. The support frame is to be installed first with the finished wall butting against it (see Figure A).

Step #1 - Install whirlpool per instructions enclosed in the whirlpool bathtub.



Step #2 – using a straight edge, mark a parallel line on the floor, 1/2" (12mm) in from the front edge of the bath (see Figure B).



Step #3 – install the apron support with the color-matched fascia facing outward. Insert under the front edge of the whirlpool. The top should contact the underside of the whirlpool bath deck between the apron support blocks and the lip of the whirlpool (see Photo #1).

Position the bottom edge of the support at the indicated line (marked in Step #2)

Step #4 - Secure the apron support to the floor using the "L" brackets, on the back of the support, and the screws provided (see Figure B).

Step #5 – Remove protective plastic film from all apron support frame fascia. Remove the protective strips from the dual-lock adhesive fasteners on the back of the apron panel (fasteners are pre-mounted to the apron panel).

Slide the top edge of the apron panel under the front edge of the whirlpool bath. Center the apron panel and push it up against the underside of the whirlpool until the whirlpool contacts the apron panel edge.

Push Bottom of apron panel against apron support frame, keeping apron panel centered. Apron panel will adhere to the fascia of apron support frame. (see Photo #2)

Apron panel may be removed by using the supplied suction cup. Place in lower left or right hand corner and pull outward away from apron support frame.

This warranty **shall be void** if the product has been moved from its initial place of installation; if it has been subjected to faulty maintenance, abuse, misuse, accident or other damages; if it was not installed in accordance with American Standard's instructions; or if it has been modified in a manner inconsistent with the product as shipped by American Standard.

American Standard's option to repair or exchange the product under this warranty does not cover any labor or other costs of removal or installation, **nor shall American Standard be responsible for any other incidental or consequential damages attributable to a product defect or to the repair or exchange of a defective product, all of which are expressly excluded from this warranty.** (Some states or provinces do not allow the exclusion or limitation of implied warranties, so this exclusion may not apply to you.)

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may have other statutory rights that vary from state to state or from province to province, in which case this warranty does not affect such statutory rights.
