


RECOMMENDED TOOLS AND MATERIALS


SPOUT ASSEMBLY

CAUTION Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.

• Insert SPOUT (1) through center hole, making sure O-RING (2) is properly seated in SPOUT BASE (3) aroove.


• Assemble RUBBER WASHER (4), BRASS WASHER (5) and LOCKNUT (6) onto SPOUT SHANK (7) from underside of sink. Make sure slot in the BRASS WASHER (5) faces toward the front of the sink.

• Tighten LOCKNUT (6) firmly.



TEE ASSEMBLY

• Thread TEE BODY (1) COUPLING NUT (2) to SPOUT SHANK (3). Tighten with wrenches.



3 INSTALL VALVE BODIES

- Thread LOCKNUT (1) to bottom of VALVE BODY (2). Make sure SPACER (3), BRASS WASHER (4) and RUBBER WASHER (5) are installed.
- Insert VALVE BODY (2) through mounting hole from underside of lavatory or mounting surface.


Note: Maximum mounting surface thickness is 1-3/8".

- Install STOP RING (6) onto VALVE BODY (2) if not in place. Install O-RING (7) into groove in HANDLE BASE (9).
- Thread FLANGE (8) onto VALVE BODY (2) until it reaches STOP RING (6), then tighten approximately 30 degrees with a wrench.
- Align HANDLE BASE (9) as shown or as desired and install onto HANDLE ADAPTER (10).
- Thread HANDLE BASE (9) onto VALVE BODY (2) until tight against its internal stop.
- Align VALVE BODY (2) and from below tighten LOCKNUT (1) to secure VALVE BODY (2).

HOSE CONNECTIONS


• Tighten COUPLING NUT (12) on SUPPLY HOSE (13) to OUTLET (11) making water tight connection.


Important: Loop SUPPLY HOSES (13) as shown so they do not kink.



4 INSTALL POP-UP DRAIN


- Unthread DRAIN STOPPER (1), rotating counter-clockwise and remove DRAIN STOPPER (1) from DRAIN BODY (2). Fig. A.
- Tighten TAILPIECE (3) on DRAIN BODY (2) before installing DRAIN BODY. Fig. B.






5 REMOVE FLANGE & LOCK SCREW

- Unthread the LOCKSCREW (1) counter-clockwise and remove LOCKSCREW (1) Fig. A
- Remove FLANGE (2) with SILICON GASKET (3) from the DRAIN BODY (4). Fig. B.







6 INSTALL DRAIN FROM BELOW FIXTURE

 From under side of SINK install DRAIN BODY (1) and SILICON GASKET (3) with the drain outlet. Fig. A.

Note: No plumber's putty or caulk is required.


 Align FLANGE (2) and SILICON GASKET (3) from above and tighten LOCKSCREW (4). Fig. B.







• Thread DRAIN STOPPER (1) clockwise onto DRAIN BODY (2).




8 FLANGE GASKET

 Check DRAIN STOPPER in SINK to ensure that SILICONE GASKET is fully compressed and not visible.



9 CHECK OPERATION OF POP-UP

• Operate DRAIN STOPPER (1) to verify that it opens and closes.




10 MAKE WATER SUPPLY AND WASTE CONNECTIONS

NOTE: FLEXIBLE SUPPLIES OR BULL-NOSE RISERS NOT INCLUDED AND MUST BE PURCHASED SEPARATELY.


Connect water supply to VALVE BODIES (1,1A) with 1/2" IPS FLEXIBLE SUPPLIES (2) or 3/8" O.D. BULL-NOSE RISERS (3). Use adjustable wrench to tighten connections. Do not over tighten. Be careful not to kink copper supply when bending. Use tubing cutter to cut to proper length.

 Connect HOT water supply to inlet of left SHANK and COLD water supply to right SHANK using sealant, appropriate connectors, and COUPLING NUTS.



11 CONNECT DRAIN

• Connect 1-1/4" O.D. tailpiece on POP-UP DRAIN to waste outlet.



12 TEST INSTALLED FITTING

- With HANDLES (1) in OFF position, turn on WATER SUPPLIES (2) and check all connections for leaks.
- Remove AERATOR (3). Loosen AERATOR (3) with AERATOR KEY (4) supplied. Pull out AERATOR (3).
- Operate HANDLES (1) to flush water lines thoroughly.
- Replace AERATOR (3) and tighten with AERATOR KEY (4).

13 CHECK DRAIN CONNECTIONS

- Check that DRAIN STOPPER (5) makes a good seal and retains water in Sink. If DRAIN STOPPER (5) does not seal properly, please refer to Troubleshooting section in these instructions.
- Push DRAIN STOPPER (5) down and check all drain connections and "P" trap for leaks. → Tighten if necessary.

TO CLEAN AERATOR

- AERATOR (3) may accumulate dirt causing distorted and reduced water flow. Remove AERATOR (3) and rinse clean.
- Replace AERATOR (3) and operate handles several times from OFF to ON position. Do not force, handles turn only 90°.
