




1 INSTALL FITTING

CAUTION Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.

NOTE: Traditional installation shown.

Contemporary faucet is installed in the same manner.

- Install SEAL (1) in groove at bottom of faucet.
- Feed FLEXIBLE FAUCET SUPPLY (2) and SHANK (3) through the mounting hole of lavatory, or mounting surface.
- From below, Install "C" WASHER (4), and LOCKNUT (5) onto faucet SHANK (3). Before final tightening, adjust faucet so that it is centered and covers mounting hole. Tighten LOCKNUT (5) using a screwdriver.



2 MAKE WATER SUPPLY CONNECTION

- Turn off cold water supply before beginning.
- Connect FLEXIBLE SUPPLY (1) directly to wall supply. Connection on fitting supply is 3/8" (10 mm) compression. Use adjustable wrench to tighten connection. Do not over tighten. Faucet supply is 30" (762 mm) long from faucet base. Figure A.

Note: If additional supply length is required, installer must purchase additional parts separately.

Important: If FLEXIBLE SUPPLY (1) is too long, loop as illustrated to avoid kinking.


3 TEST INSTALLED FAUCET


- Move HANDLE (2) into "off" position. Figure B.
- With HANDLE (2) in OFF position, turn on WATER SUPPLY (3) and check all connections for leaks.
- Operate HANDLE (1) to flush water lines thoroughly.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

Low water flow from faucet:

• Remove AERATOR (4) and clean if necessary.
