

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



1 INSTALL FAUCET


CAUTION Turn off hot and cold water supplies before beginning.

- Install SEAL (1) into groove of FAUCET BASE (2).
- Feed FAUCET SUPPLY TUBES (5) and SHANK (3) through mounting hole of lavatory or mounting surface.
- From below, Install RUBBER SEAL with RETAINING WASHER (4) and LOCKNUT (6) onto faucet SHANK (3). Before final tightening, faucet should be seated flush on mounting surface. Adjust faucet so that it is centered and covers mounting hole. Tighten LOCKNUT (6) using a 15 mm or adjustable wrench. Do not over tighten.



2 DRAIN ASSEMBLY

- Apply a bead of PUTTY around underside of DRAIN FLANGE (1) flange. Insert DRAIN PLUG (2) into SINK drain hole.
- Hold DRAIN PLUG (2) to prevent turning and assemble GASKET (3), WASHER (4), and LOCKNUT (5) from underneath sink.
- Apply sealant to threaded end of TAILPIECE and thread into lower end of DRAIN PLUG. Connect other end to trap.




3 MAKE WATER SUPPLY AND WASTE CONNECTIONS

- Connect FLEXIBLE SUPPLIES (1, 2) directly to wall supplies. Connection on fitting supplies are 3/8" (10 mm) compression. Connect left SUPPLY (1) to Hot (Marked with a Red Band) and right supply to COLD (2) wall supply.
- Faucet supplies are 24" (610 mm) long from faucet base.

Note: If additional supply length is required, installer must purchase additional parts separately.

Important: If SUPPLY HOSES (1, 2) are to long, loop as illustrated to avoid kinking.

• Connect 1-1/4" O.D. (32 mm) tailpiece on POP-UP DRAIN to waste outlet.




4 TEST INSTALLED FITTING

- Move HANDLE (1) into "off" position.
- Remove AERATOR (4) and clean if necessary.
- Turn on water supplies and check all connections for leaks.

CHECK DRAIN CONNECTIONS

• Check that DRAIN STOPPER (3) makes a good seal.

Check all drain connections and
 "P" trap for leaks. ➡ Tighten if necessary.



5 CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

DO: SIMPLY RINSE THE PRODUCT CLEAN WITH CLEAR WATER. DRY WITH A SOFT COTTON FLANNEL CLOTH.

DO NOT: DO NOT CLEAN THE PRODUCT WITH SOAPS, ACID, POLISH, ABRASIVES, HARSH CLEANERS, OR A CLOTH WITH A COARSE SURFACE.
