

ROUGH-IN INFORMATION: FREESTANDING TUB

Note: An access panel must be provided to facilitate the connection of the drain to the drain/waste outlet.

Access must be made through the floor below the tub.



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Place the tub on a finished, level floor in the desired location.


Using an erasable pencil or marker, trace the outline of the base of the tub on the floor. (See Fig. 1) $\,$

Using the adjustable feet on the underside of the tub, ensure that the tub is level.

Ensure that there is a gap between the tub base and the floor. Gap shall not exceed 3/16" (5mm). (See Fig. 2)


Remove the tub.

Using the traced outline for reference, confirm that the drain/waste outlet in the floor will align with the tub drain outlet.

(Tub drain outlet will be located in the center of the traced outline. See Fig. 3)

Note: The drain/waste outlet must be installed in accordance with all local building codes.

All drain connections must be made using an access created beneath the tub.

INSTALLING THE 1-1/2" DIAMETER TAIL PIECE ASSEMBLY INTO P-TRAP

The tail piece assembly, consisting of tail piece, drain strainer gasket and slip-joint nut used to connect the the tub drain to the drain/waste outlet, shall be provided by the installer.

A slip-joint nut, drain strainer gasket and a flanged, 1-1/2" diameter tail piece is recommended. (See Fig. 4)


Slide the slip-joint nut over tail piece towards the flanged end as shown.

Slide the P-trap slip-joint nut and seal over the tail piece as shown.

Insert the tail piece into the P-trap.

The flange of the tail piece should be approximately 2" (51mm) above the finished floor when fully inserted to the P-trap.


The tail piece can be cut if necessary.

Apply a generous bead of silicone caulking to the base of the tub including the cross-braces. (See Fig. 5)

Carefully set the tub into position. Ensure that drain strainer gasket is fully seated against the tail piece flange.

Connect the tailpiece to the tub drain. Tighten all of the drain connections. Remove any excess caulking where the tub meets the floor.

Note: Connecting the tailpiece assembly and the drain will require access from beneath the tub.

Fill the tub with water and drain. Check for leaks and re-tighten connections as necessary.

Apply a bead of Tub & Tile caulk around the bottom edge of the tub where it meets the floor.

Remove any excess caulking.

POST INSTALLATION CLEAN-UP

Remove all construction debris from bath.

Do not use wire brushes or any other metal implement on bath surface.

Post installation clean-up generally can be completed using warm water and liquid dishwashing detergent. Stubborn dirt or stains may be removed using granular Spic and Span® mixed with water.

Painter's naphtha can be used to remove excess adhesives and/or wet oil-base paint.

The colors have been formulated to enhance your choice of bathroom decorations. The high gloss surface is resistant to impact and chemicals and will retain its lasting luster with proper care and maintenance.

AFTERCARE and CLEANING

- Always fill the tub with temperate water. Excessively hot water may cause surface damage.
- Remove bath mat after use and hang to dry. Allowing bath mat to dry in the tub may cause surface damage.
- Clean after use with a mild liquid household detergent cleaner. Abrasive cleaners such as Lestoil, Lysol Disinfectant (spray or concentrate), or Lysol Basin, Tub and Tile Cleaner, Windex, Mr. Clean, Dow Disinfectant Bathroom Cleaner, or cleaning products in aerosol cans should not be used.

HARSH CHEMICALS SHOULD NEVER BE USED ON ACRYLIC SURFACES.

- Do not use wire brushes, knives or sharp objects to remove stains, cigarette tar deposits, or other surface blemishes.
- Abrasive cleaners or powders must not be used, since they will dull the surface. If the glossy surface looses its sheen, dulled areas can be restored by rubbing with a white polishing compound and waxing with a "liquid wax."
- Do not wax areas where you walk or stand.
- Do not allow nail polish remover, acetone, dry cleaning fluid, paint remover or other solvents to come into contact with the surface.
- Clean the surrounding surface immediately after using caustic drain cleaners.
- Burning cigarettes will damage the surface.
- Should damage to the fixture occur, repairs can be made. Your distributor or builder can provide details.

This limited warranty does not apply to Commercial Installations. The warranty for Commercial Installations is three (3) years.

This limited warranty DOES NOT COVER the following:

- 1. Defect or damages arising from shipping, installation, alterations, accidents, abuse, misuse, lack of proper maintenance and cleaning as directed in the Installation Instruction Manual and use of other than genuine American Standard replacement parts, in all cases whether caused by a plumbing contractor, service company, the owner or any other person.
- 2. Deterioration through normal wear and tear and the expense of normal maintenance.
- 3. Commercial application.
- 4. Options and accessories. American Standard's limited warranty on these items is one year for parts only and excludes labor. This one year limited warranty covers accessories manufactured by American Standard (e.g. aprons, drains, grab bars, heaters, trim kits) against defects of material or workmanship. Warranty coverage begins on the date the accessory was originally purchased by the owner.
